

Transport Policy

Leinster Reinforcements Ltd (LRL) are committed to minimizing the social and environmental impacts of transporting materials to and from our premises.

LRL recognises that transport is a necessary part of our business, meeting stakeholders, deliveries of raw materials and finished product. These all may have a potential impact on the environment, through vehicle emissions, fuel consumption and congestion. We are also aware that inefficient business travel results in significant and unnecessary costs to the business. Therefore, we are committed to minimising the environmental and social impacts along with costs impacts where practicable, through:

- Using GPS tracking on all our vehicles to facilitate “Just in Time” deliveries and avoid unnecessary traffic congestion with deliveries booked in at customer sites;
- Rationalizing material and customer deliveries to essential and bulk orders wherever possible;
- Hauliers are required to maintain their vehicles in good condition and must comply with all road traffic regulations;
- Hauliers must also follow the good Neighbour principles of Care, Cleanliness, Consideration, Cooperation and Commitment;
- Taking into account advancements in vehicle technology to aid the reduction of fuel used
- Regular maintenance of our fleet of vehicles to maximise efficiency and reduce Greenhouse gases where possible.

LRL will review this policy in line with all LRL policies and amend the policy when Needed to ensure continued compliance with regulations, new initiatives and best practice guides.
